## What we learn about Christmas from Philippians 2:6-11

- 1. Christmas is about an unimaginable contrast: the form of God taking on the form of a slave (2:6-7)
- 2. Christmas has a powerful point: it is not the cradle but the cross (2:8)
- 3. Christmas enjoys little acceptance from man: it is misunderstood, therefore missed (I Cor. 1:18-31)
