## The Significance of the Bible

 Produces spiritual birth – 1 Pe 1:22-25
 Promises spiritual transformation – Ps 19:7
 Promotes spiritual maturity – Heb 5:12-14 with 2 Tim 3:16-17

### **Five Questions We Must Address**

- 1. Why do I <u>NOT</u> read my Bible well?
- What should <u>I be aware of</u> as I read?
   What should <u>be my thinking grid</u> as I
  - read my Bible?
- 4. Is there <u>a best translation</u> for reading?
- 5. Is there a method of reading my Bible that will <u>improve my understanding</u>? (W.B.P.T. Model)

### 1. Why do I NOT read well?

(1) May not be saved - 1 Cor 2:13-16
(2) May be harboring sin - Ps 119:9-11
(3) May not understand - Acts 18:24-28
(4) May have been improperly taught - 2 Pe 3:15-18
(5) May not have right motives - 1 Cor 8:1-3

## 2. What should I be aware of?

<u>1 Proposition . . . 3 Parts</u>
(a) God chose to speak to man . . .
(b) . . . within various human circumstances using various methods of speech . . .
(c) . . . and He personally superintended the written record of His speech

# 3. What is the goal of my reading?

#### (1) To know what God said

- Textual criticism (not this for us today)
- Textual accuracy/literacy YOU are sensitive to God's written speech
- (2) To know what God meant by what He said
- Meaning is not for the academics, but YOU!
   (3) To know what God <u>said and meant</u> allows me to <u>now apply</u> His word to my life today
