1. Paul's 1st Missionary Journey: Acts 13-14 (A.D. 47-49)
 - Preaching (justification by faith alone), Persecution, and Perseverance *Key in Paul's 1st recorded message Acts 13:38-41
2. Paul's 1st NT Letter: Written after 1st missionary journey and before the Jerusalem Council of Acts 15 (A.D. 50)
 - 23 paragraphs in the Letter divided into 5 major sections
3. Paul's 1st Concern for the Galatian Churches: *Distortion* the Gospel and *Defection* from Grace
 - Theme: *The Gospel of Grace*
4. Paul's 1st Emphasis: 5 verses of significance (2:20 – 3:3)
 - 9 summary statements from these 5 verses
