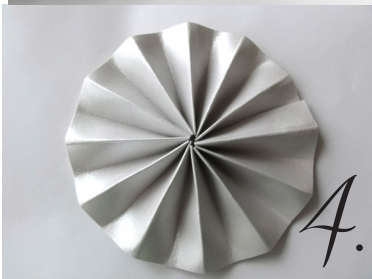
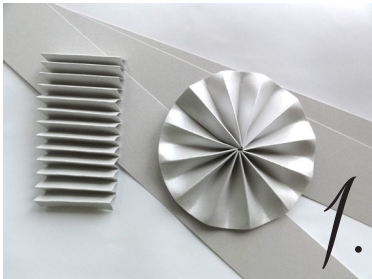


# Paper Pinwheels

## Supplies needed

Paper (cardstock is extra nice)  
Hot glue gun (or super glue)  
Button (about 1/2 inch or larger)

1. Cut paper about 11" x 1.5"  
(about the size of a desk ruler).
2. Fold paper using acordion folds: about 1 cm (or little smaller than 1/2 inch). (You may need to trim the end if last fold it too small).
3. Hot glue the ends together so that last two folded ends overlap first two folded ends. It will make a ring.
4. Pinch one side of ring together while spreading other side out.
5. Hot glue button or paper circle to center to secure the pinwheel.
