## Paper Pinuncels





Paper (cardstock is extra nice) Hot glue gun (or super glue) Button (about 1/2 inch or larger)


- 1. Cut paper about 11" x 1.5" (about the size of a desk ruler).
- 2. Fold paper using acordian folds: about 1 cm (or little smaler than 1/2 inch). (You may need to trim the end if last fold it too small).
- 3. Hot glue the ends together so that last two folded ends overlap first two folded ends. It will make a ring.
- 4. Pinch one side of ring together while spreading other side out.
- 5. Hot glue button or paper circle to center to secure the pinwheel.
